

**PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED
Concerning the Reduction in Canada Post Services**

We, the undersigned, residents of Canada, draw the attention of the House of Commons to the following:

- THAT Canada Post's plan for reduced services includes the elimination of home delivery for 5 million households as well as a drastic increase in postal rates;
- THAT, by agreeing to Canada Post's plan for reduced services, the government broke its promise to better protect consumers;
- THAT between 6,000 and 8,000 Canada Post workers will lose their jobs; and
- THAT this reduction in service could lead to the privatization of Canada Post, which is an essential public service.

THEREFORE, we call upon the Government of Canada to reject Canada Post's plan for reduced services, and explore other options for updating the Crown corporation's business plan.
